Trail Bridge Banner Policy

The Council will permit banners to be posted on various Arrowhead Trail Bridges for periods not to exceed two weeks. All signs will be installed by the Public Works Department. The following procedures and conditions shall apply:

1. Municipal Sponsored Events shall have the first priority.
2. Signs can be posted for Township based non-profit or school organizations for specific events.
3. No more than one sign shall be placed on any one side of a bridge at any time.
4. The Township reserves the right to reject a sign that is too small or constructed in a manner that it will not withstand the elements or cannot be properly secured on the bridge.
5. Non municipal sponsored organizations will only be permitted to have 1 sign request per quarter. If an organization has more than one sign request in a calendar year, their request will be preempted by a request from an organization that has not yet had a sign request in that calendar year.
6. The Township Manager will have the authority to approve signs if they comply with items 1-5. In addition the Manager shall have the discretion to make arrangements for placement of signs of specific bridges to accommodate multiple requests in a fair manner.
7. Generally non Township based/located organizations will not be permitted to have signs on the Township owned Trail Bridges. If there are unique circumstances that a non Township based organization believes would be to the benefit of the community to have a sign on a bridge, the request will be submitted to Council for consideration.
8. Organizations that place signs in other locations around the Township in violation of the Zoning Ordinance and/or without prior approval will not be permitted to have signs on the Trail Bridge.
9. Any requests not in compliance with conditions 1-4 would need to have prior Council approval.
